

Goals for Kindergarten Students

North Metro Christian Kindergarten

Language Arts

- Students will be able to read at a Level D (or higher) reader per Gwinnett County AKS.
- Students will be able to blend sounds to make words.
- Students will be able to read (at a minimum) 75 sight words without hesitation.
- Students will be able to write 1 or more sentences using inventive (phonetic) spelling, capital letters and correct punctuation.
- Students will be able to rhyme words.
- Students will be able to identify each letter, it's sound, and write it in correct block form.
- Students will be introduced to ABC order, compound words, syllables, punctuation, blends, and rules for vowels (silent e, "two vowels go walking, the 1st does the talking")
- Students will be able to retell a story, and predict what will happen in a story

Math

- Students will be able to:
 1. count to 100 by 1s, 5s, 10s.
 2. identify all shapes
 3. identify penny, nickel, dime, quarter and their values.
 4. do basic addition and subtraction (using manipulatives) and answer in number format
 5. sort by shape, size, and color
 6. identify and order numbers 0-31 and count objects to match
 7. tell time to the hour and half hour
 8. identify ordinal positions (1st, 2nd, etc.)
 9. name days of week, months of year, seasons
 10. create and interpret different types of graphs (most, fewest, more, less, equal)
 11. create patterns (AB, ABB, ABC, etc.)
 12. measure objects using nonstandard measurements, orders objects by length
 13. Identifies half and whole
 14. Uses pattern blocks and geoboards to solve spatial problems
 15. make estimations

Social Studies/ Science

- Students will be introduced to:
 1. living and nonliving
 2. the life cycles of the frog, spider, pumpkin, apple, butterfly
 3. what plants need to grow
 4. the difference between spiders and insects
 5. the parts of the insect
 6. the state of Georgia
 7. polar animals
 8. dental health
 9. weather
 10. observed National holidays
- Students will be able to state their address with zip code, birthday with year, and telephone number.

Bible

- Students will be introduced to:
 1. weekly Bible stories (beginning in the Old Testament)
 2. memory passages
- Students will be able to recite:
 1. The Lord's Prayer
 2. Luke Christmas Passage Luke 2:8-14
 3. American Flag Pledge
 4. Christian Flag Pledge
 5. Bible Pledge

Students will learn to share prayer needs and pray during the morning prayer time

Spanish

- Students will be introduced to color words, numbers, and other basic Spanish words in informal ways.

Computer

- Students will use computers to practice basic reading and math skills through computer games.
- Students will learn the appropriate way to use a mouse and keyboard.
