



North Metro Child Development Center & Christian Kindergarten 2020-2021 Protocols & Policies Relating to Covid 19 Virus

The health and safety of our children, families, and staff are of the utmost importance this school year. We have studied, conferred with other schools, and have kept up with the latest CDC guidelines regarding the Covid 19 virus. We will continue to update you with any new guidelines as we learn them ourselves.

To make this a healthy environment for all, it is going to take ALL of us to adhere to the policies. Please follow these procedures, knowing we are doing our best for everyone concerned.

Prevention Measures

Children will have their temperatures taken each morning at carpool, before entering the building. Anyone having a temperature over 100 will not be admitted. Children must be fever free without aid of any medicine. A health screen check list will also be shown to parents each morning for review.

Parents will be discouraged from entering the building after the first week. All adults must wear a face mask when in the building.

Children are not mandated to wear face masks. They are welcome to do so, but please wash them daily or use disposable masks. If they become soiled during the day, we will package them up and send home. Our staff will always wear masks other than outside or in their own classroom.

Children will sanitize hands in the foyer before going to their classroom. They will sanitize hands throughout the day. We will sanitize high touch areas throughout the day and will disinfect toys daily.

During afternoon carpool, children will remain in their rooms until called for dismissal when parent arrives.

Children who become ill during the school day will be isolated from the classroom and parents will be called. Charges to account will occur if pick up is not within 20 minutes of call.

Children will remain in their classrooms throughout the day apart from playground time. Music will be in their classroom until further notice. Chapel will be streamed on Wednesdays.

Children will have their own pencil box, filled with crayons, glue, scissors, etc. to eliminate sharing these with others.

Stay and Play, Clip on Classes and Ballet will begin in October.

If a child/staff member has two or more of the following symptoms, they cannot attend school: fever over 100, shortness of breath, new or worsening dry cough, vomiting, diarrhea, discoloration of nose drainage, any unexplained extreme fatigue of muscle aches, rash, or open sores. Child/staff member can return to school after 10 days or have two negative tests results.

In The Event

In the event a child/staff member has been exposed (within 6 feet for over 15 minutes within 2 days of the onset of person's symptoms or positive test) they are to immediately report to the school administration. They must quarantine for 14 days or have a negative test report.

In the event a child/staff member has a confirmed case but is asymptomatic, they should notify the school administration and isolate for 10 days. If they develop symptoms during the period of isolation, they may return after two negative tests results.

In the event a confirmed case has been at school, we will shut down for 3 consecutive days to clean, disinfect, and watch for additional cases from families. Teachers will call every student in the confirmed case class, but names will NOT be divulged. Emails will be sent out to other classes.

In the event more than one child/student confirmed case has been at school, we will shut down for 14 days to clean, disinfect, and watch for additional cases from families. Teachers will call every student in the confirmed case class, but names will NOT be divulged. Emails will be sent out to other classes.

Our teachers will prepare digital learning on these days missed.
